A Cultural Venue for Somerset

We are pleased to see progress on the development of The Octagon Theatre taking place behind the scenes. Somerset Council are leading the development of the theatre with funding awarded in principle from the Government and Yeovil Town Council.

A design team of architects and other specialists have been working with our theatre staff to develop new plans that will see the theatre transformed. The project is expected to cost around £15m and over the next few months will move through the various approval processes. This will include periods of public consultation where plans will be shared publicly and you'll be able to have your say. 












Project Dance Company presents: BUSK





Sennheiser Infra Red enhanced hearing headsets are available to amplify sound for patrons who are hard of hearing. They can be worn with or without a hearing aid.

Assistance Dogs are welcome in all parts of the venues. Please enquire at the Box Office when you book your seats.

Westlands is pleased to offer a choice of spaces for wheelchair users in the Ballroom - if you require assistance before or after a show, or during an interval, please ask a member of staff.
